## How students will participate:

All students will be allowed to rotate through as many stations as they choose.

Grade level times are staggered based on what time they eat lunch. No lunches will be eaten in the cafeteria. Grade levels will either eat in their classrooms or have a picnic lunch outside. Your homeroom teacher will inform you of their lunch plans. All students will wear a colored wristband to identify their grade.

**Wristband colors per gradelevel: RED=KINDER, YELLOW=FIRST, PURPLE=2ND, GREEN=3RD, BLUE=4TH**

Classroom teachers will be stationed throughout all of the playing areas and each station will have 1-2 parent volunteers.



Kinder and 1st Graders will travel in small groups and will have a 4th Grade student and/or a parent volunteer to help them around the games.

There will be ONE station for students to take their shoes off and try to pick up marbles with their toes in a baby pool filled with ice. There will also be one rest station with water. You may drop off your donation of 8 oz water bottles at the front office at anytime.

Please be sure to have your student prepared with the following:

1. Wear Bush Boosterthon t-shirt or a Bush t-shirt.
2. Change of clothes & beach towel if field conditions are muddy.
3. Water bottle labeled with their first name and at least last initial
4. Athletic appropriate shoes, hat, sunglasses, or any other needs to keep them comfortable in the sun.
5. Apply sunscreen BEFORE they come to school - We are not able to apply sunscreen at school for them.
